Detailed Itinerary


Day 1, 2 & 3

Arrive in Maun – Botswana then fly-in to Moremi **3 Nights**

Patmobile Safaris tented camp

You'll first arrive in Maun International Airport from there you'll be transferred to Moremi in a mini caravan aircraft. When you arrive at Maun International Airport, your professional guide will be waiting

to take you to the camp where you will stay for the first three nights. You are now in Botswana and the spectacular game beckons... After that short flight, you familiarise yourselves with the environment for a short game drive, with unique flora, fauna and features of your new surroundings, as you head towards your camp site. At night we gather around the campfire under a luminous African stars, share stories and enjoy the solidarity of safari experience. Camping in a private campsite allows us to visit some of the most beautiful and untouched wilderness areas in Botswana. It gives us flexibility to position our camps for the best game viewing possible.



Your accommodation is Sahara tented camp is en-suite bathrooms have bush toilets, and a bucket of hot water is provided for a bucket shower. Meals will be cooked by our amazing chef and dining will be outdoors at our dining table. You'll have the evening free to unwind and settle in after your flight.

Mammal sightings: (the rare Sitatunga, Lechwe, Lion, Leopard. Large herds of Impala, Zebra and Buffalo normally flock to the beautiful floodplains to drink water).

Day 4, 5 & 6 Transfer to Khwai River 3 Nights

Your second destination reveals the Khwai River in all its matchless glory, as you spend the day exploring its exotic sights, sounds and sensations. A buffet lunch divides a day in which the world's finest birdlife spectacles play out before your eyes with massive game viewing. We will drive to our new campsite in Khwai where our same camp that has moved from Moremi now awaits us with a warm face towel and cold refreshment.

You will have two full days here to enjoy game drives, canoeing, river cruises, nature walks, bird-



watching, and more. By now you may want to mix bird watching with boat cruise, so might choose an early morning birding walk and bush breakfast followed by a return to camp for lunch. Then, recharged after a restful afternoon, you set out once again, this time for an evening drive to witness more birdlife nightlife in action. As per the interest of the client, walking activity can be done whereby our expert guide led a walking safari. Walking in the bush with a professional guide is an exhilarating experience.

Exploring after dark with spotlights offers you a unique opportunity to experience some of the nocturnal animals that are rarely encountered during the day such as leopard, Aardwolf and porcupine and honey badger. It is important to note that night drives are not permitted within the National Parks and reserves. These activities are conducted outside the boundaries of the Moremi Game Reserve in the Khwai community area.

Mammal sightings; (Explore the 'standard' morning and afternoon game drives where you can see some of Africa's best wildlife –such as, lion, cheetah, leopard, wild dog, elephant, buffalo, hippo and giraffe).

Day 7, 8 & 9
Transfer to Savute (Chobe)
3 Nights
Patmobile Safaris tented camp

After breakfast you get to spend the following three days in Savute in the Chobe Region, heading for the places your expert tour guides believe will display the greatest abundance of glorious sightings. Stopping only for a morning tea under a sheltering tree, your expedition becomes a succession of stunning tableaux, creating a simply unforgettable day.

The Savute River has become world renowned for its mysterious disappearances that stretch over decades and sometimes to a Century. The channel has a fascinating history of flooding and drying up independently of rainy season and floods elsewhere. In addition it is a suitable place that no one would like to miss in a holiday trip. It is popularly known for its unique experience of abundance in wildlife species and beautiful landscape covered with mash of grass.

Having spent the mornings exploring the wilderness, we return to our camp for bunch and then a siesta or just relax with a book or a deck of cards during the heat of the day. All meals are seated and served in the shaded protection of a mess tent. We spend the rest of the afternoon game driving and watching water holes as the animals gather to quench their thirst whilst marvelling at yet another African sunset perhaps next to a busy hippo pool with a sun downer.



Mammal sightings; (incredible sightings for cats such as lions and leopards have been a memorable experience since the place existed. Old bull elephants are notable and permanently residing in the area flocking to the waterholes which sustain the survival of vast of wildlife during the dry season.)

Day 10:

Departure day

Today is your last day in Botswana. Enjoy your final morning activities followed by a leisurely breakfast before being collected at the camp and transferred through to Kasane International Airport, where you board your connecting flight back home.
