Day 1 - 2: Arrival; Maun International Airport, transfer to Boro River

Upon your arrival at the Maun International Airport, you will be welcomed by our professional tour guide. We will be standing outside the arrival section holding a signboard you're your name on it with Patmobile Safaris logo. Thereafter embark on a transfer en-route to your first destination with picnic lunch under a chosen sheltered tree. We should arrive at camp around sunset just in time for your first bucket shower, a unique way of showering that you can experience at any time over the next eight days, and that will be one of the memorable experience of your trip. We will meet around the camp fire for a snack and refreshments. It is in our colourful lentil lamp lit mess tent or under the starlit sky that you will enjoy your first 3 course meal that has been prepared over the fire by our incredible Chef, being setup on a

dining mess tent. Boro River is part of the Okavango delta, North Western Botswana, is the world's largest inland delta. The wetlands area supports a wide variety of wildlife. The Boro upstream flows through lagoons and floodplains and is a single more or less confined channel in the downstream discharging into Thamalakane River.

Day 3 - 5: In Khwai River

A scheduled light aircraft will transfer you to the heart of Okavango Delta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will be welcomed by your tour guide at the airstrip and be able to familiarise yourselves with the area by having an afternoon game drive. We are to arrive at the camp at sunset, to be welcomed with a warm face towels and some cold drinks to quench the thirst. After a hot shower, the day is rounded off with dinner, under canvas listening to the sounds of the African bush. Have a unique close encounter with wildlife during game viewing in Khwai Impenetrable River. The Khwai River of Moremi is one of the best places to visit for Wildlife in Botswana, and one of the few places where we can conduct night drives, and Bush Walks and experience a dug-out canoe.

Exploring after dark with spotlights offers you a unique opportunity to experience some of the nocturnal animals that are rarely encountered during the day such as leopard, Aardwolf and porcupine and honey badger. It is important to note that night drives are not permitted within the National Parks and reserves. These activities are conducted outside the boundaries of the Moremi Game Reserve in the Khwai community area. After dinner we will have time to share stories around the camp fire before retiring to bed where you will fall asleep to the many interesting sounds that the bush has to offer.

Day 6 - 8: To Moremi

Early in the morning, have your breakfast and thereafter together with your packed lunch proceed to Moremi Game Reserve. The crew will set down the camp ready for another fascinating destination. Head toward the park, stopping at several waterholes for wildlife observation and splendid views of the massive Moremi. The game viewing is usually excellent, and you'll have the chance to tick off a few new species that are not normally

seen on the grassland and swamp side of the park. Stop at a special shelter under the tree for a rest and a leisurely lunch.

The following day you'll enjoy a full day of game drives. Moremi is famous for its vegetation, which has been described as one of the best game viewing opportunities in Southern Africa—this is where you'll be spending the next three nights.
